

Painted Cabinetry: What to Expect

Painted finishes combine hardwoods and engineered materials to achieve a product with superior stability, consistency, coverage and durability. These finishes yield radiant painted cabinetry leaving natural wood grains less evident. Visible joint lines may appear due to the natural expansion and contraction of wood.



Care & Cleaning

While our laminate, painted and wood finishing processes promote durability, care should be taken to preserve the original factory finish:

- › Wipe up spills immediately
- › Use mild soaps only
- › Be sure to read all cabinet care guidelines and cleaning product instructions carefully

Environmental Factors

Cabinetry added at a later date may not match the original cabinets installed. This may be due to:

- › Exposure to sunlight, smoke and chemicals
- › Change in door samples or displays due to age (they may no longer be a true color representation)
