Thermofoil Cabinetry: What to Expect

Thermofoil is a process whereby a thick vinyl film is bonded permanently to a warpresistant engineered wood core. Because the color is throughout the film, the surface is durable, easy to clean and especially resistant to chipping and cracking.



Care & Cleaning

While our laminate, painted and wood finishing processes promote durability, care should be taken to preserve the original factory finish:

- > Wipe up spills immediately
- > Use mild soaps only
- > Be sure to read all cabinet care guidelines and cleaning product instructions carefully

Environmental Factors

Cabinetry added at a later date may not match the original cabinets installed. This may be due to:

- > Exposure to sunlight, smoke and chemicals
- > Change in door samples or displays due to age (they may no longer be a true color representation)
